

WHAT IS THE ROYAL ALEXANDRA MASQUERADE ?

* This event is an evening of dance to popular music from Glenn Miller to Madonna - big band - rock n, roll, heavy rock - country - disco- current pop - something for everyone - with an all-night light buffet & bar service. FOR AGES 19 AND OVER.

* YOU DO NOT HAVE TO BE A DANCER, OR EVEN DANCE, TO ENJOY THIS EVENT

* THIS IS NOT A COSTUME PARTY. The elaborate capes and hand-held masks can be worn for the reception & processions over clothing of your choice, and then removed and hung beside your table. The procession visuals are similar to the *Carnival of Venice*.

CAPES AND MASKS

* About 40 exotic capes (adjustable for height and girth) and hand-held masks are available for rent by contacting the Museum in advance. Photos can be seen on the web or by coming into the Museum. These are not to be taken home, but are to be picked up and put on when you arrive and taken off when you leave - simple and effective - less hassle.

* *The capes are somewhat fragile and should NOT be worn for eating or for dancing. They are to be hung beside each table, and the hand-held masks can be placed in holders at each table when not in use. They have been designed for your comfort and flexibility.*

OTHER DETAILS

* There is a circulation path around the outside of the tables to allow access to the buffet and other areas without having to cross the dance floor. The Buffet is in adjacent Reception Hall, the beverage table is in the Palm Court, and the Bar is in Entrance Hall. **Food and beverages are not to be taken onto the dance floor.**

* Registration is just inside the entrance doors, and the office is open all evening for all your information needs. There is no access to the Royal Alexandra Hall until the procession.

* **Special stage lighting and speakers** are suspended above the dance floor for ambience and clarity of music for dancers, while allowing those at tables to better converse over the music.

THE ROYAL ALEXANDRA MASQUERADE 2011 EVENING SCHEDULE

7:00 pm RECEPTION IN THE MUSEUM ENTRANCE HALL

- Registration - pick up receipts for event (and receipt for the cape &/or mask, if you have arranged for one), the gratis ticket for your complimentary Masquerade Cocktail & check coats.
- Pick up pre-ordered capes and masks which will be placed on you by Museum volunteers. Once your cape and mask are on, return to Entrance Hall and socialize until the main event starts at 8
- Enjoy your Masquerade Cocktail and the exotic colours of the capes & masks being worn.
- Purchase bar tickets & check the assigned table seating chart for your location in the Royal Alex.

7:45 The museum entrance doors will be locked for 10 minutes for preparations for the procession

* **Entrance for late-arriving guests** will be via the staff/catering door to the right of the main doors. Latecomers will not be permitted into the Entrance Hall, but will register after the procession, and will then join others in the Royal Alexandra Hall. Come early to avoid delays.

7:45 OPENING ENTERTAINMENT #1 - Val Hudson, soprano, will sing the lead from "Phantom of the Opera", which then leads into the first procession into the Royal Alex Hall.

7:50 THE FIRST "PROCESSION" TO ROYAL ALEXANDRA HALL - wear capes & masks

7:55 SHORT DANCE PERFORMANCE #2 FOR YOUR ENTERTAINMENT

The "Masquerade Waltz" by several couples to the music of Katchaturian - Randy Tapp dancers

8:00 REGULAR DANCE BEGINS - continuous for 1hr 40 min.

- a wide selection of pre-recorded uninterrupted popular dance music for people of all ages

8:20 BUFFET SERVICE BEGINS - in Reception Hall.

9:40 BREAK - ENTRANCE HALL

- all guests must go to Entrance Hall while the Royal Alexandra is tidied and the buffet is reset
- wear your masks and capes for this break

10:10 THE SECOND PROCESSION BACK TO THE HALL - with capes & masks

10:15 SHORT DANCE PERFORMANCE #3 FOR YOUR ENTERTAINMENT

Senior Ballet students from Stages School of Dance will perform - "Mystique of the Masks".

10:20 REGULAR DANCE CONTINUES - continuous for 1hr 40 min.

- bar service stops at 11:30
- buffet service stop sat 11:40

11:55 SHORT DANCE PERFORMANCE #4 TO END THE EVENING

The Midnight Waltz for 3 (from the ballet "Cinderella" by Prokofiev)

12:00 EVENT ENDS

- lights come up full and the Hall will remain open for about 20 minutes to clear the room
- Guests return capes and masks and pick up coats




